

Medicare Rebates are eligible for diagnostic mammograms as per the details stipulated by the requesting practitioner on the request form.

A Mammogram, without the necessary clinical indications on the request form, is considered screening which does not entitle the patient to a Medicare Rebate. A private fee will apply for non-Medicare Mammography exams.
